

Notice on the tourist contribution levied by the City of Frankfurt am Main for overnight guests

Frankfurt am Main is a state-recognised tourist destination.

It levies a tourist contribution since January1st, 2018. This contribution will partly cover the expenses of creating, expanding, maintaining and marketing the facilities provided for the purpose of tourism and of performing events staged for this purpose.

It is based on the statute for raising a tourist contribution in the territory of Frankfurt am Main (Tourist Contribution Statute).

With the entry into force of the first statute to amend the Tourist Contribution Statute on October 1st, 2024 all non-residents who do not have a primary or secondary residence in the City of Frankfurt am Main and pay for an overnight stay will be subject to the regulation.

The tourist contribution is two Euros per overnight stay and person and registered as well as charged by the respective place of accommodation.

The duty of paying the contribution starts on the day of arrival and ends on the day of departure. In order to calculate the tourist contribution, both days are counted together as one day.

On request, patients are released from the duty of paying a tourist contribution if they present a doctor's certificate for the time in which they were unable to make use of tourist facilities. Applications should be directed in writing to the City of Frankfurt am Main. Furthermore, pupils are released from paying the tourist contribution if they are participating in trips with their class as well as their accompanying teachers and persons who stay in the survey area only for vocational training.
